2.0 Application23/07/2015
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This schedule applies where all of the following are met:-

- The application to construct or extend one dwelling, office or retail premises on a lot.
- The application includes the substitute approved measures set out in this schedule.

3.0 Application requirements23/07/2015
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An application must be accompanied by:-

- A bushfire management statement that describes how a proposed development responds to this schedule; and
- A plan that shows how vegetation will be managed to achieve the defensible space requirements set out in the substitute approved measure AM3.1.

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Referral of application

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Decision guidelines

- Whether all of the substitute approved measures specified in this schedule have been met,
- Whether adjoining land is permanently occupied and regularly maintained, and whether this level of maintenance can be predicted to continue.
- The views of the relevant fire authority.
